Crone Middle School Students and Band Parents:

All band students have the opportunity to participate in this year's Solo and Ensemble Festival to be held Saturday, February 16th, 2019 at Gregory Middle School. Learning a solo or an ensemble and performing for a judge is an important step on the road to musical independence. Although this is not a required music department activity, **we encourage all students to participate.**

Which musical activity can I participate in at Solo and Ensemble?

- Solo (instrument and piano accompaniment)
- Ensemble (Duet, Trio, Quartet, etc...)

6th Grade Students may only perform a solo for solo and ensemble out of the Festival Solo Book 1 with approval of Mrs. Roberts.

What is solo and ensemble?

Once the student indicates interest, we will help him/her choose a piece. On February 16th, the student(s) will perform the solo or ensemble for an adjudicator who will provide a written evaluation of the performance. The judge will provide a rating based upon their performance. **This is not a competitive situation, but an opportunity for musical growth for students at any ability level.** The Solo and Ensemble experience is very similar to the solos we perform in class and technique.

How does each student prepare?

We will be available before and after school to work with students on their music. Each student will sign up for 10-minute help sessions (spread out throughout 4 weeks) that best fit his/her schedule. Look for Sign-up sheets in December/ early January. . **If you have a professional private instructor, you will not be required to come in for a help session. However, your private teacher will be signing a progress report three times before February 8th.**

Rehearsals with piano accompanists will begin in early February. 6th grade students will meet with their accompanist one time before festival. Time and date TBD

Is there any cost involved in participation?

All students performing a solo must be accompanied by a pianist. There will be a **\$30.00** fee for this service. This fee is paid directly to the accompanist and covers practice with the pianist as well as the performance on the day of the contest. An accompanist may charge more for additional rehearsals if needed for longer, very advanced solos. **Please do not send a check to school for the accompanist fee until the rehearsals with the accompanist begin in early February.**

You are also responsible for paying an entry fee. The entry fee pays for the judges, the cost of transporting and renting pianos, and other details that cost money when putting on a large event such as the Solo & Ensemble Festival.

The cost is \$9 per solo and \$5 per each ensemble member, the piano solo fee is \$12. This fee MUST be paid when you turn in the attached form. Please fill out the attached form and return to your band teacher. **Please make checks payable to Crone Middle School.**

Do I need to purchase the music for Solo and Ensemble?

Students will be responsible for the purchase of an original copy of the piece of music they choose to perform. Each student must have this original copy of the music for the Festival. This is the "judge's copy" and is required for each solo or ensemble. Students will NOT be allowed to give the judge a photocopy of the piece that they are performing.

Solo and Ensemble Schedule

All solos and ensembles will be scheduled between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on February 16th. Some special scheduling needs can be met if we know early enough, for example, "morning only because we have a wedding that afternoon." The closer we get to the actual contest date the more difficult it becomes to make changes in the scheduling. The students will be at the performance site about 1 1/2 hours total for the solo and/or ensemble experience: warm-up, performance, and waiting for the ratings.

What do you need to do as a student?

- ✓ Meet with your private teacher or band director to choose a solo and/or ensemble.
- ✓ This is a great time to begin guided practice or professional private lessons!
- ✓ Each solo or ensemble must have at least **28 measures**.
- ✓ Make sure you get plenty of help from us or your private teacher.
- ✓ Always come to the help sessions you sign up for.
- ✓ Make sure that the measures are numbered on your original copy.

What do you need to do as a parent?

- ✓ Provide transportation to the contest site (**Gregory Middle School**) and to all help sessions.
- ✓ Please be punctual to help sessions and the day of the festival.
- ✓ Be responsible for the accompanist fee and participation fee.
